

Community Treatment Orders (Supervised Community Treatment)

A One Day or a Half Day Course According to Staff Needs

Community Treatment Orders (CTOs) will be introduced in October 2008 and impact considerably on mental health services. This course examines the new power of CTOs in detail and looks at their application in practice.

Staff need to know how the new Act will affect them, their working practices and the people they provide services for. This course provides the essential knowledge staff need in order to work with and implement CTOs effectively to ensure compliance with the new legislation. Practical issues in using the new power are considered and addressed.
